Society Talents Announcement 2015

The Giovanni Goria Foundation in collaboration with **Fondazione CRT** has, since 2009, presented the "Talents of Civil Society" (**Bando Talenti della Società Civile**) programme. The programme aims to allocate annual research grants for young, studious researchers (with a diploma degree or a degree obtained through the previous system) engaged in a research project to be carried out in the area of Piedmont and the Aosta Valley.

The objective is to initiate conversations between the world of academic research and its potential practical applications, in order to encourage excellence in the Humanities and Social Sciences. Departing from the precious resources that are young graduates, the programme aims to promote recruitment through interaction between the academic world and institutions operating outside of universities.

In past years (2009 - 2014) there have been over **450 researchers** who have carried out scientific research funded by the Talents of Civil Society project. Many have already successfully completed their research, thereby offering their contribution to civil society, and demonstrating the talents that distinguish them.

The majority of these research projects stand out precisely for their operational nature, they are notable by their use of applied research their real contribution to civil society.
